Can I vote?

Yes! You have the right to vote a provisional ballot now. The Registrar of Voters will check your eligibility later.



Why can't I vote a regular ballot?

The poll worker may not have been able to confirm your eligibility to vote because:

- ★ Your name is not on the Roster of Voters for this precinct.
- ★ You are not voting in your regular precinct.
- ★ You are registered as an Absentee Voter but did not bring your Absentee Ballot with you to the poll.
- ★ In a primary election, you appear registered with a different political party than the one you say you belong to.
- You are a new voter but did not bring or do not want to show the required ID.

Will my vote be counted?

Yes, if you are properly registered to vote your ballot will be counted.

Can I confirm that my provisional vote was counted?

Yes. Call the Registrar of Voters 30 days or more after the election when the vote count is complete. Tell them the number on your provisional voting receipt, and ask if your ballot was counted.
