

Work at the Polls on Election Day!

November 2, 2010 

Who can be a poll worker?

You must be:

- ★ a U.S. citizen,
- ★ able to work on Election Day, and
- ★ registered to vote in California or a high school student in good standing and at least 16 years old

Do poll workers get paid?

Yes. The pay depends on your schedule and duties.
It is from \$130 – \$155.

What is the schedule?

Full day: 6 a.m. – 10 p.m.

Half day: 6 a.m. – 2 p.m. *or* 2 p.m. – 10 p.m.

Can I be a poll worker near where I live?

Yes. Or you can work in another part of the county.

Will I be able to vote on Election Day?

If you work at a poll that is not near your precinct, it's best to vote an Absentee Ballot before Election Day.

How do I become a poll worker?
