What happens at the conference?

- The Facilitator will review case steps, and
- Together, you will make a schedule to complete each court requirement, and set the next step in your case.

You do NOT have to go to the Conference if:

- You file an *Affidavit for Decree Without Appearance* and all other required documents before the Initial Status Conference. If the Facilitator needs more information, they may contact you.
- Both parties have lawyers, and the lawyers and both parties sign and file these documents before the Initial Status Conference:
 - *Stipulated Case Management Plan,*
 - *Financial Affidavit,* and
 - *Certificate of Compliance.*
